Over 130 species of birds have been identified on the Freeranger farm together with a wide range of other native animals.

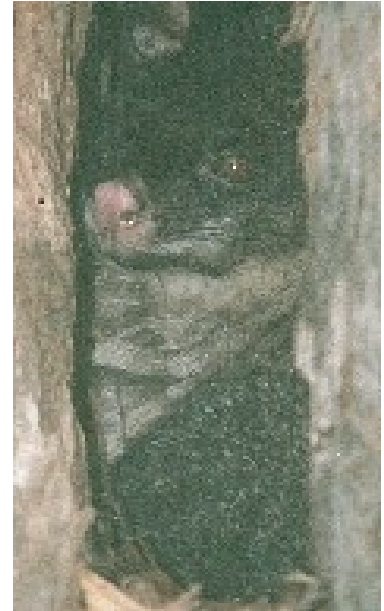
We have seven species of bats



Tree Goannas (or Lace Monitors) travel across the property at will - the dogs choose to ignore them as some are up to 3 metres long.



This is a Barking Owl but we have other Owls here too- including the Powerful Owl



Colonies of Bobuck, or Mountain Brushtail Possums, live on the property down by the river

We are more than happy to share the farm with native animals. The wildlife we love to see on the property include Koalas, Grey Kangaroos, Black Wallabies, Echidnas, Wombats, Potaroos, Bandicoots, Possums and Gliders (including Feathertail and Sugar Gliders), Antechinus, Bush Rats, Lace Monitors, Black Rock Skinks plus many other skinks, Blue Tongued Lizards and heaps more.



We have two families of Wedge Tailed Eagles which often cruise overhead - much to the dismay of the chooks. Earlier this year we witnessed a major aerial fight between the two pairs. The noise was incredible and there wasn't a chook to be seen on the place.
